A - The definitions of Application on page 2 of the Approval are deleted and substituted with the following:

7. "Application" means the application for a Renewable Energy Approval dated June 8, 2011, and signed by Sam Mantenuto, Chief Operating Officer, Northland Power Solar Burk's Falls East GP Inc., on behalf of Northland Power Solar Burk's Falls East L.P., and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to January 31, 2012, and the application for a Renewable Energy Approval dated February 20, 2013 to amend the Renewable Energy Approval number 6662-8QVM6U, and signed by Jim Mulvale, Manager, EH&S, Northland Power Solar Burk's Falls East GP Inc., and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to March 1, 2013;

All other Terms and Conditions remain the same.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Approval No. 6662-8QVM6U dated February 14, 2012

In accordance with Section 139 of the Environmental Protection Act, within 15 days after the service of this notice, you may by further written notice served upon the Director, the Environmental Review Tribunal and the Environmental Commissioner, require a hearing by the Tribunal.

In accordance with Section 47 of the Environmental Bill of Rights, 1993, the Environmental

Commissioner will place notice of your request for a hearing on the Environmental Registry.

Section 142 of the Environmental Protection Act provides that the notice requiring the hearing shall state:

1. The portions of the renewable energy approval or each term or condition in the renewable energy approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
2. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

The signed and dated notice requiring the hearing should also include:

3. The name of the appellant;
4. The address of the appellant;
5. The renewable energy approval number;
6. The date of the renewable energy approval;
7. The name of the Director;
8. The municipality or municipalities within which the project is to be engaged in;


