**Subject: Proposed Technical Changes** 

Renewable Energy Approval (No. 6662-8QVM6U)

**Burk's Falls East Solar Project** 

Northland Power Inc. is proposing to develop and operate a 10-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic (Solar PV) facility, on an approximately 80-hectares (ha) parcel of land, located southeast of the intersection of Leggetts Road and Chetwynd Road, in the single tier municipality of Armour Township; herein referred to as "Burk's Fall East Solar Project" or the "Project". The Ministry of the Environment (MOE) issued a Renewable Energy Approval (REA) for the Project (No. 6662-8QVM6U) on February 14, 2012.

Following the start of construction, it was noted that the trees located along the northern boundary of the Project site are in poor condition and could cause harm to construction workers, Project components as well as the public due to the trees proximity to Chetwynd Road. Several trees have fallen over to date, and numerous others appear to be in imminent risk of falling over. The location of these trees was included within both the archaeological assessment and the Natural Heritage Assessment for the Project as though they would be removed, and therefore further consultation with either the Ontario Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport or the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources is not required at this time. However, the removal of these trees was not identified within the site plans included in the Construction Plan Report or the Design and Operation Report. As a result, an amendment to the Renewable Energy Approval is required in order to include the removal of trees identified above.

This letter summarizes the proposed changes to the Project, including the rationale for each change, and identifies the amendments to each of the supporting documents prepared for the REA application to incorporate the proposed Project changes. This letter also provides an assessment of the potential for new negative effects not addressed in the initial REA supporting documentation.

#### 1. Proposed Project Changes

The proposed changes are as follows:

• Removal of trees located along the northern Project boundary, to be replaced by a planted buffer.

The revised site plan is provided in Attachment A.





Table 1.1 provides a description of each proposed change, the rationale for the change, an assessment of potential for altered environmental effects and any additional mitigation or monitoring required.

Overall, the proposed Project changes have minor additional negative effects not addressed in the original REA reports, however mitigation measures have been identified to minimize the effect. Based on the ability to mitigate the effect through planting of a visual buffer, the proposed changes are considered to be a Technical Amendment to the Project's existing REA.

### 2. Summary of Revisions to REA Supporting Documents

This section identifies the amendments to each of the supporting documents submitted with the REA application documents that are required to address the proposed Project changes.

The supporting documents that are amended by this letter include

- Construction Plan Report
- Design and Operations Report

The proposed tree removal had previously been considered in the Natural Heritage Assessment and Stage 1 and 2 Archaeological Assessment. As such, the proposed changes will not require additional mitigation measures than those proposed in the REA application documents. Given this, a number of the REA application documents do not require revisions as a result of the proposed changes, including

- Project Description Report
- Decommissioning Plan Report
- Natural Heritage Assessment
- Water Body Assessment
- Stage 1 and 2 Archaeological Assessments
- Heritage Assessment Reports
- Protected Properties Assessment.





The following sections identify the amendments to each of the REA application documents as a result of the proposed Project changes. For each amended report, a table is provided identifying the original text, the amended text and the original page and section of the text being amended. The tables provide the text submitted with the original REA application, the application to amend the REA and the most recent revisions in response to the currently proposed Project changes.

## 2.1 Construction Plan Report

Table 2.1 identifies the amendments to the Construction Plan Report, as a result of the changes discussed in this letter.



## Subject: Burk's Falls East Solar Project - Notice of Project Technical Change

As you are aware, Northland Power Solar Burk's Falls East L.P. is currently proposing to construct a solar project within the Township of Armour. The proposed project is named the Burk's Falls East Solar Project and will have an installed nominal capacity of 10 MW upon completion. In accordance with the provisions of the Ontario *Environmental Protection Act* Part V.0.1 and Ontario Regulation 359/09, Northland Power Solar Burk's Falls East L.P. applied to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) for a Renewable Energy Approval (REA). REA Number 6662-8QVM6U was issued on February 14, 2012.

This notice is provided to make you aware that Northland Power Solar Burk's Falls East L.P. is applying to the MOE for an amendment to the REA. This amendment is being made as it is necessary to remove the trees from the northern portion of the Project as they are in poor condition and could cause harm to construction workers, Project components as well as the public due to their proximity to Chetwynd Road. Any removed trees will be replaced with a planted visual buffer. A revised site layout is attached displaying the tree removal area.

As a result of these changes revisions to the Construction Plan Report and Design and Operations Report are required as the removal of these trees was not previously shown in the relevant site plans. Other project documents, including the Natural Heritage Assessment and Archaeological Assessment, previously considered the removal of these trees.


