The Draft Project Description Reports, titled Project Description Report Northland Power Solar Empire and Project Description Report Northland Power Solar Martin's Meadows, describe the Projects as solar electric generating facilities that will utilize photovoltaic (PV) panels installed on fixed racking structures. DC electricity generated from the PV panels is converted to AC electricity by an inverter. The voltage level of the AC electricity produced by the inverter is stepped-up to distribution level voltages by a series of transformers. 

The program brought Aboriginal education students to Thunder Bay's city hall for a day of learning about civic

Joan Esquega, a fourth-year bachelor of education student at Lakehead University, felt it was very important to partake in the engagement session at City Hall.

"We, as Aboriginal teachers, need to realize that it's important for us to bring this knowledge into our classrooms, to teach our children the importance of voting," Esquega said. "I think if we can teach them (the children) when they're younger, they'll do it as adults."

Judi Nelson Childs of the Women's Ontario Native (ONWA) Association spearheaded the session that revolved around encouraging Aboriginal voter-participation in Ontario.

"It started with a report that I did, I work for ONWA and I partnered with four people from the Leadership Thunder Bay group and we did a community action project," explained Childs. "The genesis of that report was that we knew Canadians don't vote - there's about a 50 per cent rate of voter participation across the country, for Aboriginal people it is even less."

Childs wanted to take a look at why the rate of Aboriginal voters was low. She explained that the group participated in "an extensive study that turned into a roundtable event" at Lakehead University to try to come up with ways on how to increase voter turnout. It was at Lakehead University where Childs was able to meet up with Dr. Laura Buker, a teacher in the Aboriginal Education Program, to discuss the issue.

expressed how important the participation of Aboriginal voters is, not only in municipal elections but also in Canada as a country.

"In Ontario, there are at least six or seven ridings where the Aboriginal population would be the swing vote. In Canada federally there are 60 riding where Aboriginal votes woul probably make the different (in results)," Childs said.

Childs felt it was importar to focus on Aboriginal voter more so after the Assembly (First Nations (AFN) elections.

"The fact that there were fiv women leaders who steppe forward to be a part of that wa very monumental," Childs said

Childs feels that "change upon us."

"It's a good change becaus we are asking question: wanting to be engaged," Child said. "Our younger Aborigin: people, they're the ones that ar wanting to lift things forwar so it's very important that w find places in our educatio curriculum for this."

Buker credits Leo Baska

I wanted to let you know that in addition to the Project documentation and information sent to TTN as part of the MOE's formal REA process, and in addition to the more recent meetings, emails, and discussions we have had, my colleague, Tom Hockin, was working with Howard Archibald in 2010 and 2011.

Please see the 3 attached e-mails, which I have also summarized below.

- Friday, October 29, 2010.
 - Tom Hockin spoke to Howard Archibald to introduce himself, Northland Power, and describe the project locations. An invitation to participate in the archaeology assessments was offered.
- · Saturday, October 30, 2010.
 - Tom Hockin e-mailed Howard Archibald with the project location information and sent an invitation to participate in, or observe, the archaeology assessments for the project sites.
- · Thursday July 14, 2011.
 - Tom Hockin spoke with Howard Archibald with respect to the transmission line

route, and the pending archaeological assessments for the transmission line route. TTN members were invited to observe, or participate, in the archaeology assessment.

- · Thursday, July 14, 2011.
