

# McLean's Mountain Wind Farm Community Liaison Committee

McLean's Mountain Wind LP ("the Company") received its Renewable Energy Approval ("REA") permit for the 60 MW McLean's Mountain Wind Farm project ("the Project") on October 31, 2012. As the Project enters the construction phase, the company will be forming a Community Liaison Committee ("CLC") and is seeking interested members of the community to participate.

#### Purpose:

The CLC will share feedback, ideas and information about the Project, and will provide regular updates about the Project through the construction stage and into operations.

## **Objectives:**

- To provide a forum for discussion about the Project for community members and other participants, including local municipalities, First Nations communities, federal or provincial agencies and local community groups.
- To encourage two-way communication between the Company, the community and other key stakeholders on issues relating to the Project's planned construction, installation, operation, maintenance and decommissioning.
- To engage in effective, open dialogue on the Project in order to identify opportunities for improvements and mitigation, and to work towards resolving or minimizing issues of concern.

#### **Time Commitment:**

CLC members will be asked to participate in four (4) meetings over a two-year period. Meetings will take place on weekday evenings and will last approximately 2 hours. The first meeting is expected to be held in the early spring. CLC members will be encouraged to share information relevant to the Project with and from other community members and stakeholders.

# Membership:

The CLC will include approximately 12 members broadly representing the general public, local municipalities, federal/provincial agencies and local community groups. The REA permit specifically requires that residents within 1 km of the wind farm be represented on the CLC.

We are currently inviting members of the public, both living within 1 km of the Project and the public at large, to submit a request in writing to join the CLC. Please submit your written request to the attention of Rick Martin no later than February 15, 2013, at the address or e-mail address below. If a surplus number of applications are received, a selection process will be undertaken to determine the membership.

#### About the Project

- The Project will include 24 wind turbines, each nominally rated at 2.5 MW (60 MW total).
- The Project also includes a transformer station, access roads, collector lines, main 115kV transmission line, met towers and an Operations/Maintenance building.
- The Project is located on private lands and within the municipal road allowance. A submerged power cable will cross the channel to Goat Island.
